Deepen your knowledge in any of the many subject areas and practical fields.



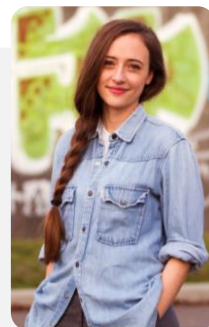
