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Most of the altogether more than 700 interviews on settlement history, land rights and early political history were carried out in north-western Ghana and south-western Burkina Faso between 1997 and 2002 in the context of two research projects under the Special Research Scheme 268, 'Cultural Development and Language History in the Natural Environment of the West African Savannah', at the Goethe University, Frankfurt/Main, Germany.

Both projects were led by Prof Dr Carola Lentz (currently at the Department of Anthropology and African Studies, Johannes Gutenberg University, Mainz) and funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG). In Project A8, 'The Politics and History of Mobile Cults in South-West Burkina Faso', Volker Linz concentrated his research on the region south of Diébougou and the area around Nako. The researchers in Project A9, 'Settlement History and Political Transformation in South-West Burkina Faso' (1997-1999) and 'Land Acquisition, Appropriation of Space and Local Identity' (2000-2002) focused on different geographical areas: Dr Richard Kuba worked among the Dagara-Wiile and the Pwo, Dr Katja Werthmann in the AVV (Aménagement des Vallées du Volta) villages, Dr Michaela Oberhofer among the Dyan, Pwo and Lobi in the Province Bougouriba, and the project director, Prof Dr Carola Lentz, among the Dagara and Sisala east of the Black Volta in both Ghana and Burkina Faso. Some interviews were conducted by colleagues from Burkina Faso, namely Simon P. Hien, Joël Somé, André Zingué and Modeste Somé.

No written agreements were concluded with the informants as nearly all of them were very aged persons (village elders) who could neither read nor write, and such a written agreement would have made little sense to them, if not altogether raised suspicions because they would not have exactly understood what they were signing. However, before every interview, the project members took great care to explain the purpose of the research project, namely to gather information about the settlement history(ies) of the area under study in order to add to the historical knowledge of the region. All of our interviewees were keen on narrating this history and related information freely. Interviews often turned into public gatherings in which younger villagers eagerly partook in order to listen to their elders' stories. All interviewees agreed to the use of a tape recorder, and many of them requested, and received, copies of the tapes that were recorded.

In the course of the two research projects, we collected settlement histories over a wide area. Altogether more than 210 settlements (ca. 150 villages in Burkina Faso and almost 60 villages in Ghana), inhabited by Dagara, Pwo, Sisala, Birifor, Dyan, Lobi and Bobo, were visited, and open or partly-standardised interviews with earth priests, their representatives, and some family elders as well as chiefs carried out. Some settlements were subsequently re-visited to clarify remaining questions.

In addition to this broad-scale data collection, a series of case studies were carried out, in which local settlement histories, village power structures and inter-ethnic relations, as well as conflicts over land rights, were discussed in depth. In addition to the project participants, who conducted case studies in Niégo, Kyetuu and Ouessa (Carola Lentz), Ouan, Saptan and Bonfesso (Michaela Oberhofer), Gnimí (Richard Kuba) and Dimouon-V3 (Katja Werthmann), in 1998 a group of MA students from the University of Frankfurt/Main carried out further case studies, in the context of a research training programme, at the following sites: Fafo

(Thorsten Bär), Bonzan (Ursula Bürger), Oronkua (Didier Knösel), Bankandi (Dorothee Leutz), Mébar (Eveline Rudolf), Dano (Dagmar Schmengler) and Badoné-V4 (Andrea Wilhelmi). Also included in the collection presented here are interviews conducted by Carola Lentz since 1989 in numerous Dagara and Sisala settlements in north-western Ghana on settlement history and the colonial transformation of the political structure, as well as a number of interviews by one MA student of anthropology (Bianka Gartelmann) from the Free University of Berlin who conducted research under Lentz' supervision in the area around Nandom.

These various research projects yielded several Master's theses and one PhD Thesis as well as numerous journal articles and several books (see bibliography below).

All the interviews are available both as audio-cassette recordings (held by the project director and the team members) and as written translations (French or English) in Word for Windows files. The present volumes represent the hard copy of these files and will be archived at the following institutions:

Thus, for the first time, there is an extensive body of oral sources on settlement histories in Ioba and Bougouriba Provinces and parts of the adjacent provinces in south-western Burkina Faso and north-western Ghana available in public institutions for further study.

The projects documented here were preceded by two similar endeavours in the late 1960s and early 1970s. Under the direction of Jean Hébert of the White Fathers, numerous historical traditions were collected, and in part published in *Esquisse d'une monographie historique du pays dagara* (written by Hébert and others in 1976; unpublished manuscript, Diébougou, Burkina Faso); Hébert deposited his research notes with the Diocese of Diébougou. At the same time, the Centre Voltaïque de Recherche Scientifique (CVRS) in Ouagadougou initiated research on history, led by Bernard Bozi Somé, who has since died. According to the CVRS activity reports from 1969-73, historical traditions, especially on settlement histories, were recorded in 150 Dagara villages. Unfortunately, the whereabouts of this material are unknown.

Note: There are problems concerning the spelling of place names and personal names, due to controversy surrounding orthographical standards in the local languages. In the case of place names, the spelling of the official IGN/IGB maps (1:200,000, sheets for Houndé, Léo and Gaoua) has usually been retained, except where these clearly deviate from local usage. In the case of ethnic names, we opted for the greatest simplicity and refrained from using diacritical signs (thus Jāane has been rendered as Dyanne, etc.).
