It is aimed at students who already have some knowledge of presentations thus, the focus is on improving existing speaking skills and working with students intensively on individual problem areas and specific difficulties. AIMS The workshop deals with spoken English for presentations and will cover some of the following common questions: How do I emphasise the important points in my presentation? What belongs in the introduction? How long should an effective introduction be? . How do I bridge the different parts of the presentation? What are some common bridging or transition words? How do I guide the audience when using PowerPoint? . When is repetition good? When is repetition bad? What are some ways to ask questions in formal situations? How do I handle answers? The course includes multiple practical exercises with individual feedback. Writing will be a very minor focus, but the instructor will address: Hyphens and hyphenation – basic rules covering when to use hyphens. Abstracts and papers - proofreading advice. Please send the following documents together with your registration: A short explanation of your current work. A summary of either a recent conference presentation or your dissertation project, for example. Imagine that you would have about three minutes to introduce your work. Five key words that describe your project. We will discuss this in the first session.
