Important Information:

- Permitted to participate are advanced students from conservatories of all nations, graduates with the major subject organ as well as organists who already practise their profession.
- A minimum number of at least 10 participants will determine whether the class will take place. Should this minimum number not be achieved until 15 September 2011 the class will be cancelled without substitution. Insofar, there is no legal claim to the realization of the class.
- No participation fee will be charged for the registration for the class.
- The participants arrange and pay their travel expenses on their own account.
- The participants are obligated to provide health care insurance and further insurance protection for their travel and their participation in the master class by themselves (please note, however, the special regulations for students enrolled at the JGU below). Prior to the start of the class, the participants declare in writing that they indemnify the AOSC and the diocese Arezzo, Cortona and Sansepolcro as well as the JGU against liability and damages for instance in case of accidents during their travel and during the course of the class.
- For students enrolled at the JGU applies the usual statutory accident insurance protection for the participation in classes, courses and other meetings and activities in the framework of the university education at the JGU.
